WE LOVE FAMILIES

At our annual meeting, we committed to prioritizing resources for **kids**, **youth**, and **worship**. We desired to utilize our resources in a way that **blessed** and **attracted** NEW **families** to our church.

- One of the great joys has been kicking off a kid's ministry. Praise God!
- At the same time, we launched Wyldlife, a ministry that reaches middle school students. Wyldlife
 sees about twelve students from Hope Academy coming to it every other week along with a few
 students outside of Hope Academy.
- We held a Spring Festival for the kids and students at YVCS Preschool and Hope Academy. That included crafts, tie-dyeing, and decorating cookies hosted by members of our church.
- Do not worry, we did not forget about the teachers. Members of our church made cookies, put together bags, and bought coffee for the teachers.
- Throughout the last couple of months, we have cultivated this connection with YVCS and Hope.

WORSHIPPING JESUS

At the beginning of January, we began looking for a part-time worship leader, who could help us **elevate Sunday mornings** and **cultivate** a **heart** of **Worship**.

- Dennis DeVilbiss has blessed our congregation for the last couple of months with his leadership.
- In March, Bob Kilpatrick joined us for a special Sunday.
- Jason Ingle, a sound technician, has been helping us behind the scenes with audio. His expertise has allowed us to produce a richer sound in church.
- We have also made a few upgrades to our sound and video equipment along with a generous donation of two professional cameras.

CULTIVATING A WARM AND LOVING COMMUNITY

- Over the past several months we have seen over forty new visitors come to our church.
- God is doing something incredible at Crossroads.
- Some of those visitors are now regular attendees and we cannot tell you how excited we are about expanding our family; you might even be one of them.

WE EMBRACE AND SUPPORT OUR COMMUNITY- USE PERMIT

Currently, we are working with the city of Concord to complete the updated use permit for our church campus. This would give Hope Academy full permission to be on our campus. Currently, they are limited where the kids can play and how much outside activity, they do because of city regulations. The **use permit requires** us to make **upgrades** to our current **facilities** like a new trash enclosure, a fence for the play yard, and adding plants.

COST INVOLVED

We are also continuing to develop our worship, reach out to new families, building our relationship with YVCS, HOPE, and Iglesias De La Familia, and grow as a church. **Part** of **growing means** there is a **cost involved**. Our **current giving** is **below** what our current expenditures are. We knew upon approving the budget for this year that it was going to be a stretch. That part of growth requires us to invest more resources and spend more.

As we step out in faith of what God is doing at Crossroads, we need to **increase** our **giving** by \$3,500 per month to meet our current YTD spending deficit.

PRAY & GIVE

As God's people, we recognize that all of creation—the earth, Scripture, relationships, talents, possessions—all good things come out of God's provision and are a gift of which we are stewards. GOD calls US to be givers, generous sharers of this abundance. In our giving, we participate in God's work in the world, and WE participate in the transforming work GOD wants to do in each of us.

As **stewards** of **creation**, we are **stewards** of **God's grace** every day. Along with such generous gifts come responsibility and a great number of questions, one of which asks,

"What are the best ways to steward God's resources?"

We **invite** YOU to **prayerfully** join Christ's church in furthering the gospel through your generous stewardship of time, talent, treasure, creation, and all of life. The words **loving** and **giving** are **scripturally synonymous**, and we can never place too much emphasis on love. 
